**Everyone is so, so happy to see students and instructors in-person!**

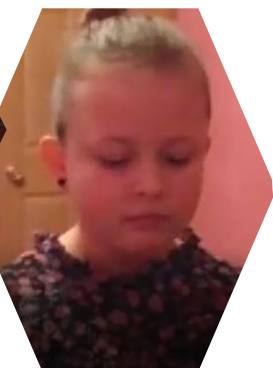
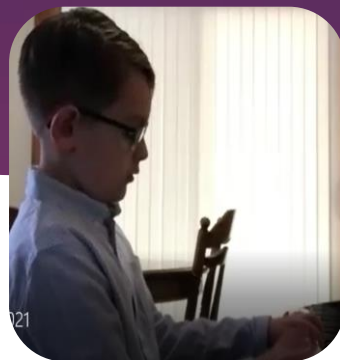
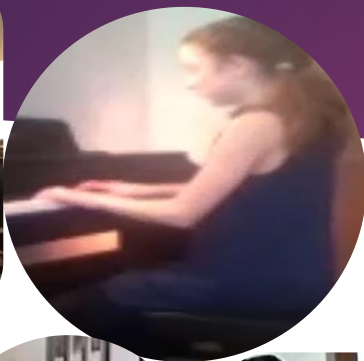
*Please know that until the CDC advises otherwise the following protocols remain intact for In-Person lessons/classes:*

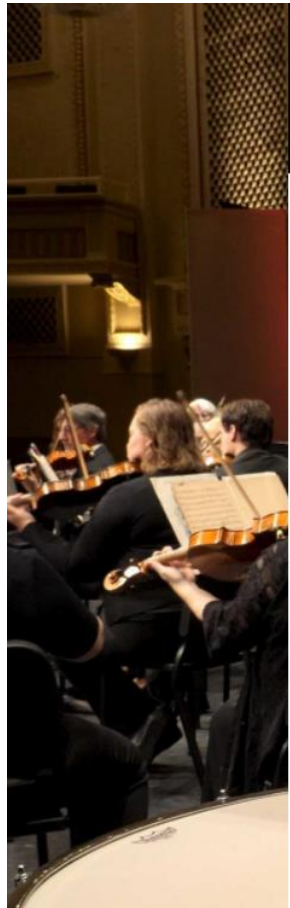

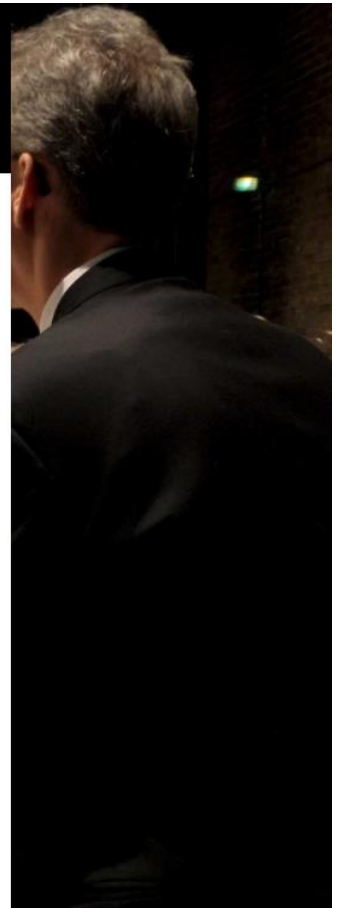
