At UTEP, Noah was recognized as the UTEP Outstanding Graduate Student in Music Performance and the UTEP College of Liberal Arts Graduate Student Marshal for his academic achievements. As a performer and educator, he often freelances as a principal violin/violist and clinician. He has also performed abroad in Italy and is an active member of the American String Teachers Association and the American Viola Society. Noah's violin teachers include Dr. Stephen Nordstrom and Leanne Kelso while being mentored in orchestral studies by Dr. Christopher Ramaekers.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE!

Recipients must contact Dr. Varshavski before each session to receive Scholarships.
Scholarships are available for children under the age of 18 of the same family at Holy Family Conservatory of Music

PRIVATE LESSONS A discount will be applied to the shorter lesson.

- Per session, if your family has three registrations (any instrument), your family will receive a 30% discount on the third registration.
- Per session, if your family has four registrations (any instrument), your family will receive a 50% discount on the fourth registration.
- Per session, if your family has six registrations (any instrument), your family will receive a 60% discount on the sixth registration.
- Per session, if your family has eight registrations (any instrument), your family will receive a 50% discount for the fourth registration AND a 100% discount on the eighth registration.

GROUP AND PRIVATE INSTRUCTION

- Per session, if your family is registered for one private lesson, one group piano, one handbell or choir, your family will receive a 25% discount for one piano group class.
- Per session, if your family is registered for two private lessons and one handbell or choir, your family will receive a 100% discount for one choir or handbell registration.
- Per session, if your family is registered for two private lessons, one handbell or choir, one Music for Tots, your family will receive a 100% discount for one Music for Tots registration.


