Sculptor in Venice Creates Giant 12-Meter-Long Violin That Floats Through Grand Canal



In one of the great cultural centers of the world—the city of <u>Venice</u>, located in northeastern Italy—one artist, Livio De Marchi (known for his boat-like wooden sculptures that float through the canals of the waterlogged city), conceived in November 2020 a floating artwork dedicated to music and musicians in the form of a colossal <u>violin</u>.

Although it does not play, it consists of everything else one would expect from a scaled-up violin: ...De Marchi's piece, titled "Noah's Violin," was created in concert with Venetian craftsmen, artists, and technicians "who on the occasion of the pandemic joined together to give life to this work ... to relaunch a sector on its knees," the artist's gallery stated. Giant musical instruments ever made cool facts to be continued

First built in Paris in 1850, the octobass is the largest string instrument ever created. It is tuned two octaves below the cello and some of its low-end notes are on the threshold of human hearing. Understandably due to its size, it is an instrument usually played by two people, with one operating the bow and the other doing the fingering. However, there are levers that can be used to push down the frets to get the right note. There isn't a huge selection of repertoire written for octobass, but here you can see it in action performing a Bach piece with four double basses at a recent festival in France.
