Born in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, violinist Anna Tsukervanik has received praise for her "ferocious" and "sensitive" performances. She gave her first solo performance at the age of eight and at fourteen received First Prize at the Glazunov International Violin Competition in Paris, France. She is also the **Grand-Prix** winner of the International Violin Competition in Alma-Ata, Kazakhstan. Anna's solo appearances include her debut recital at the Lyric Chamber Music Society in New York City, as well as performances with the Gunma Youth Festival Symphony Orchestra in Tokyo and the Hamburg Symphony Orchestra in Bukhara. Anna holds a Doctor of Musical Arts Degree from Stony Brook University (Stony Brook, NY). She is a graduate of Lynn University (Boca Raton, FL), the State Conservatoire of Uzbekistan, and the Uspensky Special Music Academic Lyceum (Tashkent, Uzbekistan).

## Concert Series at the Franciscan Center 2023-2024

Don't miss another elegant and stunning concert at the Franciscan Center!

The Pro Arte Quartet (PAQ) is one of the world's most distinguished string quartets. Founded by conservatory students in Brussels in 1912, it became one of the most celebrated ensembles in Europe in the first half of the twentieth century and was named Court Quartet to the Queen of Belgium. Its world reputation blossomed in 1919.

As the first and only quartet ever to reach its centennial anniversary (2012), PAQ's 100th birthday was the occasion of a grand, multi-year celebration.

PAQ performs throughout the United States, Europe, and Asia and continues to equally champion both standard repertoire and new music.

The group is an ensemble-in-residence at the UW–Madison Mead Witter School of Music. Together since 1995, PAQ's current members are David Perry and Suzanne Beia, violin; Sally Chisholm, viola; and Parry Karp, cello.

### Eric Carmen – All by Myself/ Rachmaninov – Piano Concerto No.2 in C minor, 2<sup>nd</sup> movement

A great '70s power ballad, reincarnated by Céline Dion in 1996, that finds the melody for its verses in Russian giant S. Rachmaninoff's most famous piano concerto – pop-classical sampling doesn't get much more iconic than this.

One of the world's biggest girl bands, Little Mix, knows the power of a good melody – as does French composer, Gabriel Fauré. Their 2013 single 'Little Me' nabs the tune of his Pavane in a lo-fi rendition in the intro, while the chorus weaves in Fauré's chord progression.
